2020 SCHOLARSHIP AWARD
(High School Level)**

Eligibility Criteria

To qualify for consideration, applicants must meet the following:

- Minimum, cumulative grade point average (GPA) 3.0.
- High school senior who will receive a high school diploma or equivalent prior to the award dispersement.
- Must be accepted at an accredited academic institution (proof of acceptance/registration and an official high school transcript will be required prior to award dispersement).
- Must pursue a degree in criminal justice or a related field and be committed to a career in the criminal justice field.
- Must complete the application and submit required documents by March 13, 2020 (if using a postal delivery service, application must be postmarked by March 13, 2020). Late, incomplete and/or illegible application packets will not be considered for awards.

Application Requirements

Applicants must submit completed application and required documents in a single envelope by Friday, March 13, 2020. Mail completed application packet to:

The application packet must include:

1. A type-written, double-spaced, 12-point font, 650 - 750 word essay (one-inch margins) outlining your career goals; action(s) taken toward achieving your future goals; reasons why you should receive an award, and how this award might assist with achievement of your goals or giving back to your community. **You must author/prepare your own essay.**
2. A copy of your most recent transcript.
3. Submit two (2) letters of recommendation in support of your application. Letters must be from a current/former faculty member, student support personnel, or a local community leader (recommendations from immediate or extended family members are not acceptable).
4. Submit a current, non-copyrighted photograph (a solo, head shot) for use in the event of scholarship selection for inclusion in program booklet. Photos will not be returned.
5. No staples or double-sided printing.

Evaluation/Selection Criteria

Applicants will be evaluated based on ability to follow instructions, academic achievements, community involvement, experience, extracurricular activities, personal recommendations, financial need and written essay.

NOBLE's evaluation of the applicant regarding each criteria shall be made in NOBLE's sole and complete discretion. Applicants will not be evaluated based on race, national origin, religious beliefs, gender, marital status, or disability.

Awardees will be selected by the scholarship committee volunteers and approved by the Executive Board of NOBLE, San Francisco Bay Area Chapter.

All applicants will be notified upon selection of final award recipients. The award recipient will be honored during the SF Bay Area NOBLE, Scholarship Gala or local event.
